All written comments received by 5:00 p.m., on or before close of business on Saturday, May 10, 2014, which pertain to the indicated changes will be reviewed and responded to by the Department of Justice's staff as part of the compilation of the rulemaking file. Please limit your comments to the modifications to the text.

Sections 999.137, 999.141, 999.143, and 999.144 are being amended to require ERDS users to utilize the appropriate publications of NIST/FIPS guidelines and to include a timeline for implementation. Grammatical errors have also been corrected.

Sections 999.137(d) and 999.139 have been omitted from these modified regulations, as amendments to these sections are no longer being proposed.
