

Release Notes April 2017, pdf

The CAPSS Release (4.8.1) was successfully implemented on April 27, 2017. This build primarily focused on enhancing specified investigative tools for the law enforcement partners that will aid in their property crime investigations and improving searching and tracking functionality.

Please note, no system program changes are required for this release.

The major enhancements for this release included:

- Added functionality to create & manage a person watch, with notifications
- Enhanced the licensing management functionality
- Enhanced Multi-Store application tracking feature
- Enhanced/fixed functionality to allow SER/OAN updates for the JUS 123 online form
- Improved search functionality

Next Planned Release is tentatively scheduled for late May 2017.

4.9.0 Release enhancements will include:

- Add functionality to create and manage an Item Watch, with notifications
- Addition of various reports for law enforcement including a NON APS article report
- Improve the functionality to sort and display requested data on various lists

The enhancements and changes scheduled for the 4.9.0 Release will not require any system program changes.
