Advertising

The Casino Real may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-000577) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino Real at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods and corresponding earned number of ticket(s).

Rules of Play

During pre-determined and posted times, Real Reward Card holders (GEGA-002398) will be eligible to earn tickets to be entered into a drawing to receive a prize. Players earn tickets for the drawing by either being dealt a certain gualifying hand, as described below, or by placing first, second, or third in a tournament. Qualifying hands will be verified by Casino personnel. Players will receive 1-10 tickets depending on the qualifying hand, as described below. The Casino will post on the gaming floor the gualifying hands eligible for entries and the number of entries awarded for achieving specified hands. Players will receive 1-10 tickets for finishing first, second, or third place in a tournament. After players have earned their tickets, their Real Rewards Card identifying number will be written on the back of the ticket and then the ticket will be placed into the drawing bin. The drawing bin will be located in plain sight inside the cashier's cage and the tickets will be placed in the drawing bin until the end of the drawing. During predetermined and posted times throughout the week, there will be a specified number of drawings where one to ten winning tickets will be drawn. The Casino shall use a random means to award the winning prizes from among the eligible persons, with the selection taking place on the casino floor and done manually. Each entry is represented by a ticket which will be standard single roll raffle tickets. They are placed in a cage like device or cylinder and mixed up. Tickets

There is no minimum qualifying hand, Casino employees are eligible to win the high hand, High Hands will be verified by a Floor Person, The current High Hand will be tracked on a poster board, Tournament games do not qualify for the High Hand, There is no restriction on the number of times a player can win the High Hand, a player does not need to be present to win and the player has thirty days to collect their prize.

Advertisement Example:

Now you can win a \$200.00 High Hand Bonus while playing in any Texas Hold'em game at Casino Real. Winner must use both hole cards in composing their five card poker hand and it must be the highest ranking hand for the qualifying period. There must be at least five players dealt in the hand in order for that hand to qualify. In the case of a tie, the \$200.00 will be split evenly. The qualifying period starts at 8:00 am of each day and ends at 8:00 am the following day. No purchase necessary. Winner may collect the \$200.00 bonus at any time after 8:00 am.

Casino Real – Omaha Jackpot

3. For all Omaha Jackpots both hole cards from the losing and the winning hand must play. Omaha Jackpots are as follows, and shall be offered together at all times that the Omaha Jackpot is being offered;

- \$3,000 \$10,000 is paid when any hand of four eights or better is beaten.
- \$1,000 \$5,000 is paid when any hand of four twos thru four sevens is beaten

Casino employees are eligible to participate in the jackpot while they are on or off duty.

Tournament games do not qualify for the Omaha Jackpots.

10. A minimum of five players must be dealt in the hand in order to qualify for Pocket Aces Cracked.

12. The availability of the Pocket Aces Cracked is general and indiscriminate. At anytime that a Pocket Aces Cracked game is in progress, any person who wants a chance to win a Pocket Aces Cracked Jackpot without playing in a live game should ask the Floor person on Shift. A table and dealer will be provided. The dealer will deal a hand to the person and enough other hands to meet the five player requirement. If the player gets pocket aces and loses at the showdown, they are eligible to win the \$20.00-\$1,000 Jackpot.

Casino employees are eligible to win this promo.

A Floor Person will verify that the hand qualifies.

The player must have two aces in the hole to qualify.

The player cannot win until the showdown which happens after all betting rounds have been completed.

The prize will be split if two players each have pocket aces beaten after the showdown.

The promotion is only valid during live play.

Example Advertisement:

POCKET ACES CRACKED

Players may receive a \$20.00 bonus each time they have pocket aces (two aces in the hole) beaten in all Texas Hold'em games! The pocket aces must be shown down at the conclusion of a hand and lose. In order to qualify, there must be at least five players dealt in the hand and the pocket aces cannot be shown or discussed before showdown. No purchase necessary. The \$20.00 bonus will be paid immediately by the cashier.

SECTION III – JACKPOTS, CASHPOTS, BONUSES, PROMOTIONS, etc.

- 2. Texas Hold'em

3. For all Hold'em Jackpots both hole cards from the losing and the winning hand must play. Hold'em Jackpots are as follows, and shall be offered together at all times that the Texas Hold'em Jackpot is being offered;

- \$50,000 when any straight flush is beaten
- \$20,000 when any hand between four eights thru four aces are beat
- \$10,000 when any hand between four twos thru four sevens are beat
- \$1,000 when any full house of aces full of jacks thru aces full of kings are beat

8. All Jackpots of \$1,000 or less are paid 100% to the qualifying hand. All Badbeat Jackpots over \$1,000 will be divided in the following manner; 50% to the losing hand, 20% to the winning hand, and 30% divided equally among the remaining players at the table who received a hand

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament
- The amount of extra tournament chips that will be awarded to each player that pays the Service Charge or Staff Appreciation Fee
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid

Tournament Log

Parkwest Casino Manteca shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of Gambling Establishment
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament
- Total number of tables used
- Name of controlled games offered
- Method of entry
- Number and amount of rebuys and/or add-ons offered
- Number of participants
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of collected.
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool
- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool
- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Printed name and signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

Eligible Controlled Games

The California Games Tournaments shall be attached to all Bureau approved California controlled games offered at Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Tournament Variations

Freeroll Tournament

- It shall be predetermined and posted when a freeroll tournament shall be offered.
- Entry is gained via Bureau approved promotions earned during specified tournament play. This shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament.
- The freeroll tournament prize pool is funded by the house at an amount ranging from \$5-\$100,000,000.
- The house may add extra funds to the existing freeroll tournament prize pool to increase the amount.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal for the initial buy-in and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or a Bureau approved gaming activity. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

*The Casino will retain the designated entry fee to offset the cost of operating the tournament. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

**Service Charge is an optional fee that will be used to pay tournament staff, make upgrades to equipment and advertisements that directly benefit the tournament area and/or its presentation. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

***Staff Appreciation Fee is an optional fee that will not become part of the prize pool. This fee is obtained for staffing cost and tips.

****Patrons who choose to pay the Service Charge or the Staff Appreciation Fee will be given, a predetermined and posted, additional amount of tournament chips. Patrons do not have to pay the Service Charge or Staff Appreciation Fee in order to participate in the tournament.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The cardroom may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed the payouts will be a cash value ranging from \$5 \$1,000,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, the Casino will fund the difference.
- When the prize pool is not based solely on buy-ins, re-buys and add-ons (free roll), the Casino will determine and set the payout structure.
- Special tournaments may be fully funded by the Casino.

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure will be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. In the event the players decide to forgo the payout structure and "split" the total prize pool among them, it shall be permitted and shall be noted in detail on the casino's tournament log.

Prizes will be awarded in the form of cash, chips, Bonus Chips (GEAR-001281), Free Play Chips (GEAR-001284), electronics, tournament entries, or merchandise that meets or exceeds the value of the prize awarded.

Entities Involved Other Than the House

Parkwest Casino Manteca shall not allow other entities to become involved in the play of California Tournaments at their gambling establishment.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Bonus Chip values
- Buy-in amount for Bonus Chips
- Limit to the amount of Buy-in's
- Procedures to redeem Bonus Chips
- Any other applicable restrictions and/or information

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bonus Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to all players who buy-in to a predetermined and posted game, for a predetermined and posted amount ranging from \$10 and \$100,000. Those players will receive standard live casino chips ("casino chips") or Bonus Chips in the amount of their buy-in and will also receive a predetermined and posted amount of Bonus Chips ranging from \$1 and \$10,000, which are to be used to buy-in to a predetermined and posted game.

The Bonus Chips are of a different style and design from the casino chips. The Bonus Chips cannot be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table for the predetermined game. Once the Bonus Chip(s) has been placed as a wager, the following applies:

- If the player wins, the player will receive casino chip(s) for their bet from the playerdealer.
 - The player retains the Bonus Chip(s) to be used again on another wager.
- If the player pushes, the Bonus Chip(s) will remain with the player until the hand loses.
- If the player loses, the Bonus Chip(s) are given to the player-dealer. The losing Bonus Chip(s) are verified by a casino representative and redeemed at the cage by the casino cage staff members for the player-dealer. A casino representative will exchange the Bonus Chips with casino chips and are given to the player-dealer.
- Players may wager the Bonus Chips on Bonus Bets.
- Bonus Chips shall not be used to pay collections or jackpot fees.
- Bonus Chips will be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to players who buy into a predetermined game at an amount between \$10 and \$100,000.
- A player shall pay all posted collection fees (if applicable) when placing a wager with Bonus Chip(s).
- The limit to the number of times a player may participate in the Bonus Chip Promotion during a promotional period will be predetermined and posted.
- Players cannot exchange Bonus Chips for live casino chips.
- Bonus Chips are non-transferable between players.
- Bonus Chips do not expire.
- Players can take Bonus Chips home and use them at a later date.
- Bonus Chips have no cash value and cannot be redeemed for cash at any time.
- There is minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, required in the controlled game for this promotion.
- Bonus Chips will only be redeemed for the player-dealer after having been played and verified by a casino representative.
- Casino employees off duty and out of uniform are eligible for the promotion.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to use Bonus Chips to settle wagers.
- Tournament games are not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Backline bettors may participate in this gaming activity.
- Bonus Chips can be used in combination with live casino chips.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to use Bonus Chips.

<u>Prize</u>

The prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 and \$10,000 in the form of Bonus Chips.

Funding

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Manteca. There will no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bonus Chip Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

The Parkwest Casino Manteca may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should</u> the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001284) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Match Play Coupon and/or Free Play Chip Voucher value(s)
- Procedures to redeem coupons and/or vouchers
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match Play & Free Play Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded Match Play Coupons or Free Play Chip Vouchers via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. Both the Coupons and the Vouchers will have the name of an eligible game and a face value clearly printed on them. The value for both the Match Play Coupons and the Free Play Chip Vouchers will range between \$5 and \$5,000. Players who receive a Match Play Coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if they place a base game wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the match play coupon. Players who receive a Free Play Chip Voucher will be eligible to redeem the voucher for Free Play Chips, in the value of the voucher, to be used only as a base game wager at the eligible game printed on the voucher. The procedures are as follows:

Match Play Coupon

- To use a Match Play Coupon a player must place a base game wager, equal to the face value of the coupon, and the Match Play Coupon in the appropriate betting area for the game listed on the coupon.
 - The coupon will be counted as part of the total base game wager in terms of winning or losing.
 - It will also be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.
- If the player wins the hand they will be paid their wager as well as the listed amount on the Match Play Coupon by the player-dealer.
 - The coupon will be collected by the house dealer.
 - A casino representative will sign the coupon and will drop it in the drop box for accounting purposes.

- If the player loses the hand they will lose the wager and the coupon.
 - The money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer.
 - The coupon is taken to the cage by the casino representative.
 - At the cage the coupon will be logged, and exchanged into live casino chips for the value listed on the coupon.
 - The live casino chips will then be given to the player-dealer.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the player will keep the coupon and be able to keep using it until the player loses or wins a hand.

Free Play Chip

- When a player receives a Free Play Chip Voucher they shall take the voucher to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the Free Play Chip(s) to be used in a live game.
 - Free Play Chips are of a different style and design from the standard casino chip.
 - The Free Play Chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash and they can only be used on the game specified on the voucher.
- Free Play Chips shall be used as the player's base game wager and placed on the appropriate betting circle.
 - It will also be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.
- Free Play Chips shall not be taken into the house dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray.
- If the player wins the hand they will be paid like normal by the player-dealer.
 - The Free Play Chips will be collected by the house dealer.
 - A casino representative will then verify that the chips have been played and will drop the chips in the drop box for accounting purposes.
 - If the player loses the hand they will lose the wager and the Free Play Chip(s).
 - The Free Play Chips will be collected by the player-dealer.
 - A casino representative will verify that the Free Play Chips have been played and will take the chips to the cage.
 - At the cage the Free Play Chips will be logged, and exchanged into live casino chips for the value listed on the Free Play Chips.
 - The live casino chips will then be given to the player-dealer.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip(s) may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of one player and a player-dealer is required to be playing in any of the games, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- Each Match Play Coupon and Free Play Chip Voucher will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon or chip for.
- Players shall not exchange the Match Play Coupons for live chips or give them to another player.
- Players shall not give Free Play Chip Vouchers or Free Play chips to another player.
- Match Play Coupons and Free Play Chips are not eligible to be used on bonus bets.

- Casino employees who are off duty and out of uniform will be eligible to participate in the promotion.

- There is no limit to the amount of times a player may win a prize.

The Match Play Coupons and/or Free Play Chips shall have a fixed value ranging from \$5 to \$5,000. The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a casino representative.

Funding

The Match Play & Free Play Promotion will be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Manteca. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play & Free Play Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Manteca may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the</u> <u>Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001282) will be referenced on all</u> <u>advertisements relating to this gaming activity.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Required amount of time to be played and corresponding points earned
- The date(s) and time(s) the activity shall be offered
- All prizes offered and specific amount of points required for each prize
- The time frame in which the points earned are valid
- When the bonus prize(s) will be offered throughout the promotion
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Customer Incentive Program shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Customer Incentive Program is a loyalty reward program open to all Parkwest Casino Manteca patrons. The promotion will assign players with a player rewards card and reward players with points based on time of play at designated tables during predetermined and posted time periods ranging from 10 minutes to 90 days.

Player's Card Computer System Description

The player's card shall include the casino name, some descriptive language regarding restrictions for the card, and the problem gambling phone number. There shall also be a bar code.

- Players will receive a player's card once they sign up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier.
 - Players may sign up and receive a player's card at any time.
- Player information shall be maintained in a secure database accessible only by casino management. Access to the database shall also be tracked by casino management
 - No one except the network administrator(s) has access to the back-end systems where the data is stored.
 - Access to the data is by user level with multiple levels based on the users work needs.
 - Marketing managers will have access to customer data for marketing purposes.
- The card shall be non-transferable and can only be used by the player who the card is assigned to.
- If the player's card is lost or stolen, they can ask a casino representative for a replacement at no cost to the player.

- A computer device, with a barcode reader, will be affixed to the gaming table or casino podium.
- Player's time is tracked by having a casino representative either scan or manually enter the card information into the compute device.
- The casino representative will also input the player's average wager and time played into the computer device.
- A printable record of the amount of time a player has accumulated during the promotional period shall be available at any time it is requested by the player.
- If the Player's Card Computer System should stop working during the promotion, information will be manually tracked and entered in the computer system once it starts working.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays at a predetermined and posted table and has their player's card scanned by a casino representative will earn points based on time played, which can be redeemed for prizes during or at the end of a predetermined and posted promotional period. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 200,000. During predetermined and posted times, bonus rates may be offered by the Casino (for example, double points may offered during off-peak hours).

Example: A player signs up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier and receives a player's card. The player presents the card to a casino representative at the gaming table. The casino representative enters the player into the tracking software and will input the type of game and average wager per hand in 15 minute increments. At the end of the gaming session, the player will be logged out by the casino representative. The tracking software tabulates the amount of points the player earned based on time played and adds it to the player's account. The player may check their point balance and redeem points with a casino representative at any time during the promotion.

How Player Rewards Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a predetermined and designated value. Points shall be earned by the amount of time played during the promotional period. After a player has accumulated a predetermined and specific amount of points, a player may redeem the accrued points for a predetermined and designated prize. When predetermined and posted, points may also be redeemed for money in these cases 1 point will be worth \$0.01 to \$100.

- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion.
- Players may redeem their points for multiple prizes so long as the total amount of points required for all prizes is within the player's point balance.
- Once points are redeemed by the player, they are deducted from their point balance.
- Points are non-transferable and may only be redeemed by the player that earned them.
- Points may be redeemed at any point during or at the end of the posted promotional period. Points that are not redeemed at the end of the promotional period will expire within 30 days.
- All reward points are subject to review and verification. The Casino reserves the right to adjust balances or void points due to any error or fraud.
- A player may check their point balance with a casino representative at any time during the promotion.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Players must be 21 or older and provide a valid ID to sign up for a player's card.
- In order for a poker game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players dealt in to the game.
- In order for a California game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, dealt in to the game.
- Backline bettors are eligible for this promotion.
- Casino employees are not eligible for this promotion.
- Third Party Proposition Players are not eligible for this promotion at any time.
- A patron who assumes the player-dealer position will not be logged out of the system and shall continue to have their time tracked.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000. Prizes include cash, live casino chips, Bonus Chips (GEAR-001281), Match Play Coupons/Free Play Chips (GEAR-001284), vehicles, promotional merchandise, food, entry into tournaments (GETR-000130), or entry into the Cash and Prize Drawings (GEAR-001283).

Bonus Prize

The casino may also offer a Bonus Prize. When offered, players who reach a predetermined and posted point level will qualify for a Bonus Prize. The Bonus Prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000.

All prizes for this promotion will be predetermined and posted in advance throughout the gaming floor, and in all literature promoting such event.

Funding

The Customer Incentive Program shall be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Manteca. No additional fees of any kind shall be taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Manteca shall not retain any administrative fee as this promotion is house-funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Customer Incentive Program does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary Table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Manteca may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the</u> <u>Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001283) shall be referenced on all</u> <u>advertisements relating to this gaming activity.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Applicable qualifying hand chart.
- Number of tickets that will be awarded for qualifying hands.
- Number of tickets that will be awarded for time played.
- Procedures and requirements for drawing tickets.
- Drawing dates and times.
- Prizes that shall be available to win for each drawing.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Object and Summary

The Cash and Prize Drawings promotion awards players with 1 to 20 tickets which are used to enter a drawing, where the player can win fixed prizes ranging from \$1 to \$500,000.

There are three different ways in which a player may earn tickets:

- <u>Qualifying Hand</u> during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets when they obtain a predetermined qualifying hand. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players who play one of the listed games and obtain a listed qualifying hand will win the corresponding amount of tickets.*
- <u>Time Played</u> during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets by playing a predetermined game for a predetermined amount of time. A player's time will be tracked through their player's card or manually on a log controlled by a casino representative. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players will earn 5 tickets for every hour they play one of the listed games.*

• <u>Time Played and Qualifying Hand</u> – during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets by completing either of the options mentioned above. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players will earn 5 tickets for every hour they play one of the listed games and may earn additional tickets by obtaining a listed qualifying hand and winning the corresponding amount of tickets.*

Once a player has earned a ticket(s) the following will occur:

- A casino representative will verify the qualifying hand and/or time played and award the ticket(s).
- The player will receive a standard raffle ticket(s) that will be divided into two sections one section for the player and one section for the Casino.
- The player must retain their portion of the ticket(s) to claim their prize.
- The player will fill out the casino section of the ticket(s) with their first and last name, name of game, table number, and date.

- Both sections of winning tickets will be retained by the Casino for 90 days.

In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions necessary in order to participate and qualify for the Cash and Prize Drawing promotion.

Qualifying Hands

When the Cash Prize Drawing promotion is being offered with a qualifying hand option a player that makes a qualifying hand, as listed below, shall be eligible to win the posted number of drawing tickets. Only one qualifying hand option shall be offered during a promotional period. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

* When the Cash Prize Drawing promotion is being offered with a time played option a player may earn 1 to 20 tickets per hour of play.

Eligibility Requirements

No Purchase Necessary

In order to participate in the VIP Prime Membership promotion patrons need to first be members of the Customer Incentive Program. They will then sign-up and pay a corresponding monthly fee. A VIP Prime Member Card will be given to members to represent their membership status in the Customer Incentive Program and the VIP Prime Membership.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players 21 years of age and older with valid I.D.

- This gaming activity is restricted to Customer Incentive Program members (GEAR-001282).
- Participants may sign up for the Customer Incentive Program and the VIP Prime Membership on the same day.
- Participants must pay the monthly fee on time.

- Tournament games are eligible for this gaming activity.

<u>Prize</u>

The VIP Prime Membership offers fixed prizes which range in value from \$1 to \$500,000. The eligible prizes are grouped into two categories; Complimentary Prizes and Independent Prizes.

Complimentary Prizes

Independent Prizes

Independent prizes are awarded independent of any currently active gaming activities and consist of; cash, live casino chips, merchandise, food, California Games Tournament Entries (GETR-000130), gift cards, electronics, limousine service, event tickets, private dining, shoe shine service, valet and preferred parking, private events, ride share service, and car wash service.

Example of an Independent Prize: During the month of August all VIP Prime Members will receive free Valet Parking.

Participants in this gaming activity must claim their prize within the posted promotional period using their VIP Prime Membership card. Some prizes may be offered in limited quantities. In the event an offered prize is unavailable or exhausted, a substitute prize or prizes will be offered to all remaining VIP Prime Members within the posted promotional period.

Funding

Membership Fees

Parkwest Casino Manteca shall charge patrons a monthly membership fee to participate in the gaming activity. The monthly fee shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$50 to \$500. The price of the monthly fee will be advertised and posted. Participants must pay the monthly fee on time. If a patron does not pay the monthly fee within the month's five day grace period, the membership will be cancelled. In addition, to accommodate a customer, per casino management's discretion, the monthly fee can be waived. Object and Summary

The Poker Pyramid Promotion is a house funded promotion that awards players, who are participating in an eligible controlled game, and who achieve a qualifying hand, a predetermined and posted prize from the pyramid. A Poker Pyramid board is used to track eligible prizes and eligible qualifying hands. The board consists of two parts: the qualifying hands, which make up the base, and the prizes, which make up the pyramid (see below for an example of a pyramid). There are a total of 36 qualifying hands and a total of 36 prizes.

Poker Pyramid Promotion Procedures:

- The Casino will advertise the eligible game(s) and promotional period for the Poker Pyramid Promotion.
- The Casino will post the Poker Pyramid board prominently near the eligible gaming tables.
 - If more than one game is eligible, the casino will post a Poker Pyramid board for each eligible game.
 - Each eligible game will be independent of any other eligible games.
 - All tables participating in the same eligible game will share the corresponding Poker Pyramid board.

- Staff and surveillance cameras will monitor and maintain the Poker Pyramid board's accuracy, thus ensuring patrons and employees do not tamper with the Poker Pyramid board.
- Players will participate in the eligible game(s) as a seated player.
 - Backline bettors cannot participate in this promotion.
- If the player achieves an eligible qualifying hand, listed in the base of the Poker Pyramid, a casino representative will confirm the hand.
- Once the hand has been confirmed the player will immediately receive the corresponding prize.
 - Prizes are not determined by the qualifying hand, but rather by the order in which a qualifying hand has been achieved.
- The casino representative will then remove the qualifying hand from the Poker Pyramid board and that qualifying hand will no longer be eligible to receive a prize.
 - The hand will remain ineligible to receive a prize for the remainder of the promotional period.
- The casino representative will also remove the corresponding prize and that prize will no longer be eligible to be won.
 - The prize will be ineligible to be won for the remainder of the promotional period.
- Prizes are awarded in sequence from left to right, one row at a time until the row is empty.
 - An entire row of prizes must be completed before the next row of prizes will be offered.
- After the removal of a prize, the next prize in sequence will be awarded to the next qualifying hand achieved.
 - No specific sequence is required to make the qualifying hands.
- This will continue until there is one prize left (the top of the pyramid) and, therefore, one qualifying hand left on the pyramid base.

Qualifying Hands

Players who achieve an advertised qualifying hand, as shown below, will be eligible to win a predetermined prize. Both the qualifying hand and the eligible prize must be available based on the Poker Pyramid board. All qualifying hands within the chart below must be offered together at all times when the promotion is offered for play.

- For Ace Up Pai Gow Poker and Lucky Pai Gow Poker, base game rules for jokers apply, no deviation is allowed. Furthermore, as long as a below listed qualifying hand is achieved, the setting of hands is irrelevant for the promotion; the qualifying hand is the best five cards of the seven cards dealt.
- For Texas Hold'em and Ultimate Texas Hold'em, to form a qualifying hand as listed below, players must use of both hole cards and three of the community cards.
- For the game of Omaha to form a qualifying hand as listed below, players must use two hole cards and three community cards. The two hole cards must be used as part of the Three of a Kind part of the qualifying hand. *Example: If the qualifying hand is three 5s and a Pair of 2s then the player would need to have two 5s as hole cards, and use one 5 and a Pair of 2s from the community cards.*
- For 3 Card Poker the qualifying hand will be determined based on the player and playerdealer combined hands.

Poker Pyramid Promotion Qualifying Hand Chart

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- Each game will have a corresponding pyramid for payouts.
- Each above mentioned controlled games will be independent of the other controlled games.
- Each of the above mentioned controlled games will have its own pyramid board.
 - If multiple tables of the same controlled game are in play, all tables for the controlled game will be eligible for the promotion and will share the same board.
- Backline bettors cannot participate in the promotion nor win a prize even if the base game rules allow backline betting.
- Multiple prizes may be awarded during the same round of play.
 - Prizes will be awarded in the order the qualifying hands are achieved.
- If multiple players have qualified with different eligible hands at the exact same time;
 - The first available prize will be awarded to the player closest to where the action begins per the base game rules,
 - The prize and hand will then be removed from the board.
 - The next available prize will be awarded to the second closest player to where the action begins.
 - This process of awarding available prizes followed by removing eligible prizes and hands from the Poker Pyramid board will continue until all eligible hands have received an available prize.

- If multiple players have qualified with the same eligible hand at the exact same time;
 - For purposes of the Poker Pyramid board the win will be treated as if only one player had won.
 - One eligible hand and one prize will be removed from the Poker Pyramid board.
 - For purposes of prize payout each eligible hand will receive the full prize.
 - The prize will not be shared.
 - For instances where the prize is not a cash/chip item the player closest to where the action begins, per the base game rules, will receive the prize item and the other players will receive the items listed cash value in live casino chips.
- There is no limit to the amount a prizes a player may win during a promotional period.
- Two players minimum are required for the games of Texas Hold'em and Omaha.
- Two players minimum are required for the above mentioned eligible controlled California games, the player and player-dealer.
- In all California games, except 3 Card Poker, patrons who assume the player-dealer position are eligible to win a prize.
 - In 3 Card Poker patrons who assume the player-dealer position are not eligible to win a prize.
- Third Party Provider of Proposition Player Services, on and off duty, will not be eligible to participate in the promotion.

Funding

Parkwest Casino Manteca will fund the Poker Pyramid Promotion. There will be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Manteca will not retain any administrative fees for this gaming activity as it is house-funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Poker Pyramid Promotion will be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Casino will provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material will state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Poker Pyramid Promotion</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Advertising

The Parkwest Casino Manteca may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should</u> the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001280) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Parkwest Casino Manteca at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

Object and Summary

The Multi-Game Jackpot features a fixed and a progressive jackpot prize. Players must pay an optional \$1 jackpot fee in order to be eligible to win the prize and achieve a designated qualifying hand as listed below.

California Games

A prize is awarded to players, who have paid the \$1 jackpot fee, in any of the eligible California Games referenced above, when the player-dealer has been dealt a qualifying hand as listed below. After the hand is confirmed, those players who have paid the jackpot fee shall receive the posted prize from the progressive jackpot or the fixed prize jackpot dependent on the qualifying hand.

Poker Games

A prize is awarded to players, whom have paid the \$1 jackpot fee, in any of the eligible Poker games referenced above, based on the community cards dealt as listed below. The \$1 jackpot fee will be placed on the betting circle in front of each seat at the table. After the hand is confirmed, those players who have paid the jackpot fee shall receive the posted prize from the progressive jackpot or the fixed prize jackpot dependent on the qualifying hand.

Qualifying Hands

California Games

When the player-dealer makes one of the following advertised qualifying hands during the play of an eligible California Game, as listed above, all players who paid the jackpot fee shall be eligible to win their share of the posted Multi-Game Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Only the hands that have been Bureau approved and designated by the Casino are eligible. <u>All gualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.</u>

Poker Games

When a qualifying hand is made from the community cards on an eligible poker game, as listed above, all players who paid the jackpot fee shall be eligible to win their share of the posted Multi-Game Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Only the hands that have been Bureau approved, predetermined, and designated by the Casino are eligible. <u>All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.</u>

* The hand must be achieved using the cards in the flop (the first three community cards), in order to be eligible for the fixed prize in the poker games.

California Game Example: Prior to the play of the hand, five players placed a jackpot wager. The jackpot hand is made by the player-dealer, and the posted prize is \$42,000. Each of the five players would then receive \$8,400.

Poker Game Example: Prior to playing the hand, eight players placed a jackpot wager. A royal flush jackpot hand is made with the five community cards, and the posted prize is \$40,000. Each of the eight players would receive \$5,000.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- There is a minimum of two players (player and player-dealer for California Games) required to be dealt in during an eligible game in order for the players to qualify for the jackpot prize.
- The \$1 jackpot collection fee shall be placed on the designated betting circle for both California and Poker games.
 - The fee will be collected at the completion of every hand. When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify that the hand qualifies.
- Players are eligible to win this promotion more than once.
- Casino employees who are off duty, and out of uniform, shall be eligible to participate to win in the Multi-Game Jackpot Promotion.

California Game Specific

- Backline bettors are eligible to participate in this jackpot. However, the base game rules must allow for backline betting and there must be an open backline betting position.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Players Services (TPPPS) shall not be eligible to participate and win in the California games of the Multi-Game Jackpot.
- A patron in the player-dealer position shall be eligible to win their share of the fixed/progressive prize, so as long as they pay the jackpot fee and achieve a qualifying hand.
- California Tournament Games are not eligible for this promotion.

Poker Game Specific

- Poker proposition players are eligible to participate in this jackpot.
- Poker Tournament Games are not eligible for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The jackpot prize is a fixed and a progressive jackpot with a minimum value of \$5 and a maximum of \$1,000,000. Every eligible game has the opportunity to win either the progressive or the fixed prize, depending on the qualifying hand.

The fixed jackpot prize shall be paid out in the form of cash, live casino chips, merchandise, trips, tournament entries and electronics. If the value of the prize is lower than the advertised fixed jackpot, the Casino will make up the difference with another form of prize listed above.

The progressive prize will be paid out in live casino chips, or cash, and the amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as how much time was accumulated in order for the jackpot to increase progressively each day.

Prize Payout Structure

There is only one prize pool. The California games patrons and Poker games patrons will be playing for the same progressive and fixed prizes. The payout shall be split evenly for the posted progressive amount among the players who placed a jackpot bet and have qualifying hands. If a qualifying hand is made with a fixed prize amount, each player who placed a jackpot bet will receive the entire posted amount.

• For California Games, payouts will be made to each active player and any backline positions for this position, then payout to the next active position and backline bettor, and continue in this procedure.

Funding

The Multi-Game Jackpot gaming activity utilizes one jackpot account and shall be funded by the \$1 jackpot collection fee. The jackpot collection fee shall be dropped into a separate drop box marked as "jackpot".

The prize pool shall be initially seeded at a minimum of \$5,000. The jackpot has a cap of \$1,000,000. If the jackpot reaches the cap amount, all other jackpot fees collected shall be placed in the jackpot reserve account.

The prize pool will be increased daily at predetermined and designated times with an amount ranging from \$5 to \$10,000 based on the amount collected. After increasing the progressive prize pool, any extra amount accumulated that day will be added to the reserve fund. - The Casino shall initially seed the jackpot.
- The Casino will be reimbursed when the reserve account has sufficient funds.
- The Casino will cover any shortfall.
 - The Casino shall be refunded by the reserve account when there are sufficient funds.
- If there are insufficient funds in the reserve account, the Casino shall absorb the cost until there are sufficient funds in the reserve account.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Manteca shall retain an administrative fee of \$5-\$10 per table per hour from all eligible California and Poker games and will be taken from the reserve account. This fee will be used to cover advertising for the jackpot prize, security to pull and count the boxes, accounting, equipment, surveillance, and the cost of the gambling establishment personnel that administer the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Multi-Game Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Multi-Game Jackpot</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.
