

Bonus Chip Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001305) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Bonus Chip values
- Buy-in amount for Bonus Chips
- Limit to the amount of Buy-in's
- Procedures to redeem Bonus Chips
- Any other applicable restrictions and/or information

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bonus Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to all players who buy-in to a predetermined and posted game, for a predetermined and posted amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000. Those players will receive standard live casino chips ("casino chips") or Bonus Chips in the amount of their buy-in and will also receive a predetermined and posted amount of Bonus Chips ranging from \$1 to \$10,000, which are to be used to buy-in to a predetermined and posted game.

The Bonus Chips are of a different style and design from the casino chips. The Bonus Chips cannot be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table for the predetermined game. Once the Bonus Chip(s) has been placed as a wager, the following applies:

- If the player wins, the player will receive casino chip(s) for their bet from the player-dealer.
 - The player retains the Bonus Chip(s) to be used again on another wager.
- If the player pushes, the Bonus Chip(s) will remain with the player until the hand loses.
- If the player loses, the Bonus Chip(s) are given to the player-dealer. The losing Bonus Chip(s) are verified by a casino representative and redeemed at the cage by the casino cage staff members for the player-dealer. A casino representative will exchange the Bonus Chips with casino chips and are given to the player-dealer.
- Players may wager the Bonus Chips on Bonus Bets.
- Bonus Chips shall not be used to pay collections or jackpot fees.
- Bonus Chips will be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.

Bonus Chip Promotion

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to players who buy into a predetermined game at an amount between \$10 to \$100,000.
- A player shall pay all posted collection fees (if applicable) when placing a wager with Bonus Chip(s).
- The limit to the number of times a player may participate in the Bonus Chip Promotion during a promotional period will be predetermined and posted.
- Players cannot exchange Bonus Chips for live casino chips.
- Bonus Chips are non-transferable between players.
- Bonus Chips do not expire.
- Players can take Bonus Chips home and use them at a later date.
- Bonus Chips have no cash value and cannot be redeemed for cash at any time.
- There is minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, required in the controlled game for this promotion.
- Bonus Chips will only be redeemed for the player-dealer after having been played and verified by a casino representative.
- Casino employees off duty and out of uniform are eligible for the promotion.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to use Bonus Chips to settle wagers.
- Tournament games are not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Backline bettors may participate in this gaming activity.
- Bonus Chips can be used in combination with live casino chips.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to use Bonus Chips.

Prize

The prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000 in the form of Bonus Chips.

Funding

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Marina. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bonus Chip Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should Parkwest Casino Marina advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001309) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Match Play/Free Play Coupon/Chip values
- Procedures to redeem Match Play/Free Play Coupons
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match Play/Free Play Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded Match Play Coupons or Free Play Chip Vouchers via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. Both the Coupons and the Vouchers will have the name of an eligible game and a face value clearly printed on them. The value for both the Match Play Coupons and the Free Play Chip Vouchers will range between \$5 and \$5,000. Players who receive a Match Play Coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if they place a base game wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the match play coupon. Players who receive a Free Play Chip Voucher will be eligible to redeem the voucher for Free Play Chips, in the value of the voucher, to be used only as a base game wager at the eligible game printed on the voucher. The procedures are as follows:

Match Play Coupon/Chip

- To use a Match Play Coupon a player must place a base game wager, equal to the face value of the coupon, and the Match Play Coupon in the appropriate betting area for the game listed on the coupon.
 - The coupon will be counted as part of the total base game wager in terms of winning or losing.
 - It will also be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.
- If the player wins the hand they will be paid their wager as well as the listed amount on the Match Play Coupon by the player-dealer.
 - The coupon will be collected by the house dealer.
 - A casino representative will sign the coupon and will drop it in the drop box for accounting purposes.

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

- If the player loses the hand they will lose the wager and the coupon.
 - The money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer.
 - The coupon is taken to the cage by the casino representative.
 - At the cage the coupon will be logged, and exchanged into live casino chips for the value listed on the coupon.
 - The live casino chips will then be given to the player-dealer.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the player will keep the coupon and be able to keep using it until the player loses or wins a hand.

Free Play Chip

- When a player receives a Free Play Chip Voucher they shall take the voucher to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the Free Play Chip(s) to be used in a live game.
 - Free Play Chips are of a different style and design from the standard casino chip.
 - The Free Play Chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash and they can only be used on the game specified on the voucher.
- Free Play Chips shall be used as the player's base game wager and placed on the appropriate betting circle.
 - It will also be counted as part of the base game wager in terms of Total Table Action for collection rates.
- Free Play Chips shall not be taken into the house dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray.
- If the player wins the hand they will be paid like normal by the player-dealer.
 - The Free Play Chips will be collected by the house dealer.
 - A casino representative will then verify that the chips have been played and will drop the chips in the drop box for accounting purposes.
- If the player loses the hand they will lose the wager and the Free Play Chip(s).
 - The Free Play Chips will be collected by the player-dealer.
 - A casino representative will verify that the Free Play Chips have been played and will take the chips to the cage.
 - At the cage the Free Play Chips will be logged, and exchanged into live casino chips for the value listed on the Free Play Chips.
 - The live casino chips will then be given to the player-dealer.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip(s) may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of one player and a player-dealer is required to be playing in any of the games, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- Each Match Play Coupon and Free Play Chip Voucher will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon or chip for.
- Players shall not exchange the Match Play Coupons for live chips or give them to another player.
- Players shall not give Free Play Chip Vouchers or Free Play chips to another player.
- Match Play Coupons and Free Play Chips are not eligible to be used on bonus bets.

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

- Casino employees who are off duty and out of uniform will be eligible to participate in the promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for the promotion.
- Tournament games are not eligible for the promotion.
- There is no limit to the amount of times a player may win a prize.

Prize

The Match Play Coupons and/or Free Play Chips shall have a fixed value ranging from \$5 to \$5,000. The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a casino representative.

Funding

This promotion will be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Marina. There will be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Marina will not retain an administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play/Free Play Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001307) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Applicable qualifying hand chart.
- Number of tickets that will be awarded for qualifying hands.
- Number of tickets that will be awarded for time played.
- Procedures and requirements for drawing tickets.
- Drawing dates and times.
- Prizes that shall be available to win for each drawing.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

Object and Summary

The Cash and Prize Drawings promotion awards players with 1 to 20 tickets which are used to enter a drawing, where the player can win fixed prizes ranging from \$1 to \$500,000.

There are three different ways in which a player may earn tickets:

- Qualifying Hand – during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets when they obtain a predetermined qualifying hand. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players who play one of the listed games and obtain a listed qualifying hand will win the corresponding amount of tickets.*
- Time Played – during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets by playing a predetermined game for a predetermined amount of time.

Cash and Prize Drawings

A player's time will be tracked through their player's card or manually on a log controlled by a casino representative. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players will earn 5 tickets for every hour they play one of the listed games.*

- Time Played and Qualifying Hand – during a predetermined time period a player may earn a predetermined amount of tickets by completing either of the options mentioned above. *Example: On May 5, 2025 from 6 AM to Midnight players will earn 5 tickets for every hour they play one of the listed games and may earn additional tickets by obtaining a listed qualifying hand and winning the corresponding amount of tickets.*

Once a player has earned a ticket(s) the following will occur:

- A casino representative will verify the qualifying hand and/or time played and award the ticket(s).
- The player will receive a standard raffle ticket(s) that will be divided into two sections one section for the player and one section for the Casino.
- The player must retain their portion of the ticket(s) to claim their prize.
- The player will fill out the casino section of the ticket(s) with their first and last name, name of game, table number, and date.
- The player will then hand the casino portion of the ticket(s) to the casino representative.
- The ticket(s) will then be placed in a barrel or other non-electronic randomizer.
- All tickets will be the same color and size.
- At the predetermined time, a casino representative will announce the drawing, spin the barrel and draw a ticket.
- The player whose ticket is selected will win the predetermined and posted prize.
- The tickets are only valid for the current promotional period and expire at the end of the promotional period.
- At the end of the promotional period the barrel or other non-electronic randomizer will be emptied and the remaining tickets will be destroyed.
- Both sections of winning tickets will be retained by the Casino for 90 days.

In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions necessary in order to participate and qualify for the Cash and Prize Drawing promotion.

Qualifying Hands

When the Cash Prize Drawing promotion is being offered with a qualifying hand option a player that makes a qualifying hand, as listed below, shall be eligible to win the posted number of drawing tickets. Only one qualifying hand option shall be offered during a promotional period. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

* When the Cash Prize Drawing promotion is being offered with a time played option a player may earn 1 to 20 tickets per hour of play.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players (a player and a player-dealer) shall be dealt into the game in order for the table to qualify for the promotion.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify that the hand qualifies. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the hand.
- Players are eligible to earn a drawing tickets regardless of if their hand wins, loses, or ties in the base game.
- Tickets are non-transferrable and can only be used by the player who earned them.
- There is no limit to the amount of tickets a player may earn during a promotional period.
- A player can only win one prize per drawing per day. If a player has more than one winning ticket drawn per day, the casino will have one of the following, predetermined and posted options:

Cash and Prize Drawings

- The Casino may draw another ticket until there is a winner. In this case the players tickets that are not eligible to win will be set aside until a winner is pulled and then put back in the randomizer for future drawings.
- Or the Casino may choose to rollover the prize and wait until the next scheduled drawing time to draw another ticket. In this case the players ticket that is not eligible to win, will be put back in the randomizer for the future drawing.
 - This option will not be available on the last scheduled drawing.
- A player must be present to win.
- The player whose ticket is drawn will have to provide their portion of the winning ticket or a valid ID.
- The player whose ticket is drawn shall have two minutes to claim their prize. After two minutes the ticket shall be discarded and destroyed.
 - If the prize is not claimed within two minutes of drawing the ticket, the Casino may draw another ticket until there is a winner, or the Casino may choose to rollover the prize and wait until the next scheduled drawing time to draw another ticket.
 - The option to rollover the prize will not be available on the last scheduled drawing.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying hands, each player with a qualifying hand shall receive the predetermined number of drawing tickets.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion.
- Casino employees are not eligible to participate in this activity.
- Third-Party Proposition Players shall not be eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Backline bettors are eligible to participate in this gaming activity
- The player-dealer position is eligible to participate in this promotion.

Prize

A player who has their ticket drawn shall win a predetermined and advertised fixed prize ranging in value from \$1 to \$500,000; including cash, live casino chips, Match-Play Coupons or Free Play Chips (GEAR-001309), Bonus Chips (GEAR-001305), tournament entries (GETR-000132), merchandise, gift cards, food vouchers, tickets to attractions and movies, electronics, trips, and vehicles. In all instances the prize shall be predetermined and posted in the casino.

Funding

The Cash and Prize Drawing promotion will be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Marina. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Cash and Prize Drawings shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. **All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Cash and Prize Drawings. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.**

Customer Incentive Program

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001308) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Required amount of time to be played and corresponding points earned
- The date(s) and time(s) the activity shall be offered
- All prizes offered and specific amount of points required for each prize
- The time frame in which the points earned are valid
- When the bonus prize(s) will be offered throughout the promotion
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Customer Incentive Program shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Customer Incentive Program is a loyalty reward program open to all Parkwest Casino Marina patrons. The promotion will assign players with a player rewards card and reward players with points based on time of play at designated tables during predetermined and posted time periods ranging from 10 minutes to 90 days.

Player's Card Computer System Description

The player's card shall include the casino name, some descriptive language regarding restrictions for the card, and the problem gambling phone number. There shall also be a bar code.

- Players will receive a player's card once they sign up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier.
 - Players may sign up and receive a player's card at any time.
- Player information shall be maintained in a secure database accessible only by casino management. Access to the database shall also be tracked by casino management
 - No one except the network administrator(s) has access to the back-end systems where the data is stored.
 - Access to the data is by user level with multiple levels based on the users work needs.
 - Marketing managers will have access to customer data for marketing purposes.
- The card shall be non-transferable and can only be used by the player who the card is assigned to.
- If the player's card is lost or stolen, they can ask a casino representative for a replacement at no cost to the player.

Customer Incentive Program

- A computer device, with a barcode reader, will be affixed to the gaming table or casino podium.
- Player's time is tracked by having a casino representative either scan or manually enter the card information into the compute device.
- The casino representative will also input the player's average wager and time played into the computer device.
- A printable record of the amount of time a player has accumulated during the promotional period shall be available at any time it is requested by the player.
- If the Player's Card Computer System should stop working during the promotion, information will be manually tracked and entered in the computer system once it starts working.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays at a predetermined and posted table and has their player's card scanned by a casino representative will earn points based on time played, which can be redeemed for prizes during or at the end of a predetermined and posted promotional period. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 200,000. During predetermined and posted times, bonus rates may be offered by the Casino (for example, double points may offered during off-peak hours).

Example: A player signs up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier and receives a player's card. The player presents the card to a casino representative at the gaming table. The casino representative enters the player into the tracking software and will input the type of game and average wager per hand in 15 minute increments. At the end of the gaming session, the player will be logged out by the casino representative. The tracking software tabulates the amount of points the player earned based on time played and adds it to the player's account. The player may check their point balance and redeem points with a casino representative at any time during the promotion.

How Player Rewards Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a predetermined and designated value. Points shall be earned by the amount of time played during the promotional period. After a player has accumulated a predetermined and specific amount of points, a player may redeem the accrued points for a predetermined and designated prize. When predetermined and posted, points may also be redeemed for money in these cases 1 point will be worth \$0.01 to \$100.

- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion.
- Players may redeem their points for multiple prizes so long as the total amount of points required for all prizes is within the player's point balance.
- Once points are redeemed by the player, they are deducted from their point balance.
- Points are non-transferable and may only be redeemed by the player that earned them.
- Points may be redeemed at any point during or at the end of the posted promotional period. Points that are not redeemed at the end of the promotional period will expire within 30 days.
- All reward points are subject to review and verification. The Casino reserves the right to adjust balances or void points due to any error or fraud.
- A player may check their point balance with a casino representative at any time during the promotion.

Customer Incentive Program

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Players must be 21 or older and provide a valid ID to sign up for a player's card.
- In order for a poker game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players dealt in to the game.
- In order for a California game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, dealt in to the game.
- Backline bettors are eligible for this promotion.
- Casino employees are not eligible for this promotion.
- Third Party Proposition Players are not eligible for this promotion at any time.
- A patron who assumes the player-dealer position will not be logged out of the system and shall continue to have their time tracked.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion.

Prize

The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000. Prizes include cash, live casino chips, Bonus Chips (GEAR-001305), Match Play Coupons/Free Play Chips (GEAR-001309), vehicles, promotional merchandise, food, entry into tournaments (GETR-000132), or entry into the Cash and Prize Drawings (GEAR-001307).

Bonus Prize

The casino may also offer a Bonus Prize. When offered, players who reach a predetermined and posted point level will qualify for a Bonus Prize. The Bonus Prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000.

All prizes for this promotion will be predetermined and posted in advance throughout the gaming floor, and in all literature promoting such event.

Funding

The Customer Incentive Program shall be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Marina. No additional fees of any kind shall be taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Marina shall not retain any administrative fee as this promotion is house-funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Customer Incentive Program does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary Table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

California Games Tournaments

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GETR-000132) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament
- The amount of extra tournament chips that will be awarded to each player that pays the Service Charge or Staff Appreciation Fee
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid
- Non-Cash prizes that will be awarded and their monetary value.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid
- Any other restrictions that apply to the California Games Tournaments

Tournament Log

Parkwest Casino Marina shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of Gambling Establishment
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament
- Total number of tables used
- Name of controlled games offered
- Method of entry
- Number and amount of rebuys and/or add-ons offered
- Number of participants
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of collected.
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool
- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool
- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Printed name and signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

California Games Tournaments

Eligible Controlled Games

The California Games Tournaments shall be attached to all Bureau approved California controlled games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

- All approved California games

Tournament Variations

Freeroll Tournament

- It shall be predetermined and posted when a freeroll tournament shall be offered.
- Entry is gained via Bureau approved promotions earned during specified tournament play. This shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament.
- The freeroll tournament prize pool is funded by the house at an amount ranging from \$5-\$100,000,000.
- The house may add extra funds to the existing freeroll tournament prize pool to increase the amount.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- **Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.**
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal for the initial buy-in and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or a Bureau approved gaming activity. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

Tournament Structure

*The Casino will retain the designated entry fee to offset the cost of operating the tournament. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

**Service Charge is an optional fee that will be used to pay tournament staff, make upgrades to equipment and advertisements that directly benefit the tournament area and/or its presentation. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

California Games Tournaments

***Staff Appreciation Fee is an optional fee that will not become part of the prize pool. This fee is obtained for staffing cost and tips.

****Patrons who choose to pay the Service Charge or the Staff Appreciation Fee will be given, a predetermined and posted, additional amount of tournament chips. Patrons do not have to pay the Service Charge or Staff Appreciation Fee in order to participate in the tournament.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The cardroom may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed the payouts will be a cash value ranging from \$5 - \$1,000,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, the Casino will fund the difference.
- When the prize pool is not based solely on buy-ins, re-buys and add-ons (free roll), the Casino will determine and set the payout structure.
- Special tournaments may be fully funded by the Casino.

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure will be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. In the event the players decide to forgo the payout structure and “split” the total prize pool among them, it shall be permitted and shall be noted in detail on the casino’s tournament log.

Prizes will be awarded in the form of cash, chips, Bonus Chips (GEAR-001305), Free Play Chips (GEAR-001309), electronics, tournament entries, or merchandise that meets or exceeds the value of the prize awarded.

Entities Involved Other Than the House

Parkwest Casino Marina shall not allow other entities to become involved in the play of California Tournaments at their gambling establishment.

California Games Jackpot

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001306) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prizes
- Procedures to redeem prizes
- Availability of No purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The California Games Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Pure 21.5 Blackjack (GEGA-000309)
- No Bust 21st Century Blackjack (GEGA-001003)
- Cash-In Baccarat (GEGR-002193)
- Lucky Pai Gow Poker (GEGR-002194)
- EZ Baccarat Panda 8 (GEGA-003832)

Object and Summary

The California Games Jackpot offers players the opportunity to win both fixed and progressive prizes. The California Games Jackpot considers the player-dealer's hand based on the qualifying chart below.

- To begin each round, players may make their regular base game wager on any predetermined and posted eligible game. They may place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1.
 - A player does not have to place a base game wager in order to place the optional jackpot fee.
 - The house dealer will collect all jackpot fees and drop them in a separate box marked "Jackpot".
- The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.

California Games Jackpot

Qualifying Hands

When the player-dealer makes one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, players who placed the \$1 jackpot fee will be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the payout options, as shown below. All qualifying progressive and fixed hands within a chart and listed below must be offered together at all times.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify the qualifying hand. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- Backline betting is allowed for this jackpot.
- Players who are playing multiple hands may not place a jackpot fee on each hand. They may only place a jackpot fee on the seat they are sitting at.
- A player is not required to place a base game wager in order to place a jackpot fee.
- There is no limit to the amount of times a player may win a prize during the promotional period.
- There is no minimum or maximum number of players required to be dealt in during an eligible game in order for players to be eligible and the tables to qualify for the California Games Jackpot.
- Players in the player-dealer position will be eligible to place a jackpot fee and participate in the California Games Jackpot promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate and win the promotion when off duty.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the jackpot.

California Games Jackpot

- Third-Party Proposition Players (TPPPS) are not be eligible to participate in the promotion when on or off duty.

Prize

The California Games Jackpot features both progressive and fixed prizes. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Progressive Prize

The progressive prize will range from a minimum of \$10,000 to a maximum of \$500,000. The actual amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as how much time was accumulated in order for the jackpot to increase progressively each day.

- 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter shall be awarded to players when the following requirements are met:
 - In the game of 3 Card Poker, the player-dealer's hand is a Five Card Royal Diamond Flush constructed using any combination of the player-dealer's cards and the cards of any other player.
 - In the games of Pure 21.5 Blackjack and No Bust 21st Century Blackjack, the player-dealer's hand is 8-8-8 with all cards being of a diamond suit.
 - In the game of Cash-In Baccarat and EZ Baccarat Panda 8, the Banker's Hand wins with three cards totaling 7 and all three cards are of a diamond suit.
 - In the games of Lucky Pai Gow Poker, the player-dealer's hand is a Seven Card Diamond Straight Flush without a Joker.
- If more than one progressive prize winning hand hits at the same time all winning players will split the prize evenly.
 - In the event there are an odd number of chips to split between winners, the Casino will ensure each patron is paid the same amount and will cover any shortfall at their expense.

Fixed Prizes

Fixed prizes will awarded at a set amount of \$500, \$1,000, or \$5,000 depending on the qualifying hand. Prizes may be paid out in the form of cash, live casino chips, merchandise, trips, poker tournaments entries (GEGA-000629), or electronics.

- \$500 will be awarded to players when the following requirements are met:
 - In the game of 3 Card Poker, the player-dealer's hand is an ace, king, and queen with all red cards.
 - In the games of Pure 21.5 Blackjack and No Bust 21st Century Blackjack, the player-dealer's hand is 8-8-8.
- \$1,000 will be awarded to players participating in Cash-In Baccarat or EZ Baccarat Panda 8 when a Banker Hand wins with three cards totaling 7 and all cards are of a red suit.
- \$5,000 will be awarded to players when the following requirements are met:
 - In the game of 3 Card Poker, the player-dealer's hand is an ace, king, and queen with all cards being of a diamond suit.
 - In the games of Pure 21.5 Blackjack and No Bust 21st Century Blackjack, the player-dealer's hand is 8-8-8 with all red cards.

California Games Jackpot

- In the games of Lucky Pai Gow Poker, the player-dealer's hand is Seven Card Diamond Straight Flush with a joker.
- Prizes will be paid from the reserve fund and will not be deducted from the amount shown on the progressive meter.
- In the event more than one fixed qualifying hand hits at the same time all winning players will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

Funding

The California Games Jackpot is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive elements, which is funded by an optional \$1.00 jackpot fee. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$10,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the California Games Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records.

The California Games Jackpot has a \$500,000 prize cap. Once the cap has been reached all future jackpot fees will be placed in the reserve fund.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded from the reserve fund at an amount between \$10,000 and \$50,000. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed prize amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

The progressive prize meter shall increase daily at an amount between \$5 and \$10,000 based on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. If less than \$5 are collected and assigned for the prize meter the difference will be made up by the reserve fund. If the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up the short fall and will be reimbursed by the reserve fund when monies become available. If more than \$10,000 are collected and assigned for the prize meter the overage will be added to the reserve fund. Each \$1.00 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.25 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.75 will be tracked in a reserve fund.

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging in an amount between \$1 and \$10, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee shall be used for the operation costs and the administration of the jackpot.

California Games Jackpot

No Purchase Necessary

The California Games Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the California Games Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

VIP Prime Membership

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Parkwest Casino Marina may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001304) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Procedures for purchasing the VIP Prime Membership
- Monthly price of membership
- The date(s) and time(s) the promotion shall be offered
- Any limits to the amount of prizes a VIP Prime Member may win during the promotional period.
- Any limitations to the quantity of a prize.
- The games eligible for the promotion
- Eligible prizes, prize quantities, and prize values
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The VIP Prime Membership promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Parkwest Casino Marina at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The VIP Prime Membership promotion is an enhancement to the Customer Incentive Program (GEAR-001308). The VIP Prime Membership will offer patrons who sign up and pay a monthly fee, the opportunity to participate and win prizes that are both complimentary and independent to those awarded in the Customer Incentive Program and other gaming activities.

In order to participate in the VIP Prime Membership promotion patrons need to first be members of the Customer Incentive Program. They will then sign-up and pay a corresponding monthly fee. A VIP Prime Member Card will be given to members to represent their membership status in the Customer Incentive Program and the VIP Prime Membership.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players 21 years of age and older with valid I.D.

- This gaming activity is restricted to Customer Incentive Program members (GEAR-001308).
- Participants may sign up for the Customer Incentive Program and the VIP Prime Membership on the same day.
- Participants must pay the monthly fee on time.
- Participants may pay the monthly fee with credit card, cash, live casino chips, or Customer Incentive Program points.
- All VIP Prime Members are subject to the same monthly fee.
- VIP Prime Members will be guaranteed at least one opportunity to participate and win a prize per month.

VIP Prime Membership

- Promotional periods in this gaming activity are equal to one month.
- A VIP Prime Membership card will have the player's name and membership number. If the card is lost or stolen, a replacement will be replaced free of charge.
- The VIP Prime Membership is non-transferable.
- Casino employees are not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS), on or off duty, shall not be eligible to participate in this promotion.
- A VIP Prime Member is eligible to participate in this promotion while in the player-dealer position.
- There is no limit to how many VIP Prime Membership prizes a player may win during the life of their membership.
- Any limit to the amount of prizes a VIP Prime Member may win during a promotional period will be predetermined and posted.
- A participant in this promotion must claim any advertised prizes within the posted promotional periods
 - A prize will not be awarded to participants after a promotional period has ended, regardless if the monthly fee was paid.
- Tournament games are eligible for this gaming activity.

Prize

The VIP Prime Membership offers fixed prizes which range in value from \$1 to \$500,000. The eligible prizes are grouped into two categories; Complimentary Prizes and Independent Prizes.

Complimentary Prizes

Complimentary prizes are prizes that compliment a currently active gaming activity. These prizes will be awarded in addition to the prize awarded by the gaming activity. These prizes consist of receiving additional:

- Bonus Chips for buying into the Bonus Chip Promotion (GEAR-001305)
- Points during the Customer Incentive Program (GEAR-001308)
- Drawing Tickets for participating in the Cash and Prize Drawings promotion (GEAR-001307)
- Free Play Chips when participating in the Match Play & Free Play Promotion (GEAR-001309)

Example of a Complimentary Prize: *Every Mondays in the month of August, patrons who participate in the Bonus Chip promotion by buying into an eligible game for \$2,000 will receive \$250 in Bonus Chips. All VIP Prime Members who buy-in to the Bonus Chip promotion for \$2,000 will receive an additional \$100 in Bonus Chips for a total of \$350 in Bonus Chips.*

Independent Prizes

Independent prizes are awarded independent of any currently active gaming activities and consist of; cash, live casino chips, merchandise, food, California Games Tournament Entries (GETR-000132), gift cards, electronics, limousine service, event tickets, private dining, shoe shine service, valet and preferred parking, private events, ride share service, and car wash service.

Example of an Independent Prize: *During the month of August all VIP Prime Members will receive free Valet Parking.*

VIP Prime Membership

Participants in this gaming activity must claim their prize within the posted promotional period using their VIP Prime Membership card. Some prizes may be offered in limited quantities. In the event an offered prize is unavailable or exhausted, a substitute prize or prizes will be offered to all remaining VIP Prime Members within the posted promotional period.

Funding

The VIP Prime Membership shall be fully funded by Parkwest Casino Marina.

Membership Fees

Parkwest Casino Marina shall charge patrons a monthly membership fee to participate in the gaming activity. The monthly fee shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$25 to \$1,000. The price of the monthly fee will be advertised and posted. Participants must pay the monthly fee on time. If a patron does not pay the monthly fee within the month's five day grace period, the membership will be cancelled. In addition, to accommodate a customer, per casino management's discretion, the monthly fee can be waived. Participants may pay the monthly fee with credit card, cash, live casino chips, or Customer Incentive Program points.

Administrative Fees

Parkwest Casino Marina shall not retain an administrative fee for this promotion as it is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The VIP Prime Membership does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.
