Governor's Proposal Fails Black Students

“Newsom’s plan would target the lowest-income schools that educate about 5% of all students and only 6% of Black students.”

- EdSource, January 24, 2023

Under the Governor’s proposal only 5% of the \$300 million Equity Multiplier funds will go to Black students.

Alternative Equity Multiplier Proposal

Fund any student group that receives performance levels worse than the state on two or more state indicators on the California School Dashboard. Only pupils in those student groups who do not receive other state or federal supplemental funding will receive this Equity Multiplier funding. Pupils funded pursuant to this section shall be deemed to be unduplicated pupils for the purposes of Ed Code section 42230.07 and any other statutes for which resources are allocated based on unduplicated pupil counts.

Alternative Equity Multiplier, based on two or more state indicators below the state All Students group, truly targets the lowest performing students.

Under the Governor's Proposal, all student groups except for Filipino and Asian are the focus of additional funding under the Equity Multiplier. Chronic Absenteeism qualifies all but two student groups as lowest performing.
